Footnotes

AMERICAN CHALLENGE, well placed in behind rivals from early on, saved ground for a half, came out five wide for the drive, reached the front about the sixteenth pole and drove clear under steady left-handed encouragement. SET TO SPARKLE drifted out at the start while breaking alertly, angled inside quickly, opened a clear advantage approaching the end of the backstretch, was joined by LADIES PRECEPT from the outside on the turn, made the pace into the final furlong and wasn't a match for the winner late. LADIES PRECEPT went up three abreast early to track the winner, inched after that one on the turn, continued close up into the final furlong and was empty late. NO SMALL WONDER, well placed between horses near the inside for a half, came out five wide for the drive but failed to offer a closing account. RUN RAYMA RUN, within striking distance and five or six wide throughout, failed to rally. HELLACIOUS CURVE, outsprinted early, failed to threaten and was six wide in the stretch run. NO PARDON, checked after the start, raced in contention in behind rivals to the stretch three or four wide and was empty in the drive. PARIS PAST failed to reach contention. CAVILLING raced forwardly between rivals into the stretch and faltered. GREE LEE DEE tired inside on the turn. CORONDA ROSE, six or seven wide on the backstretch, edged in five wide on the turn but never menaced.
