Footnotes

TARZAN CRY (IRE), unhurried early, followed the leaders three or four wide under patient handling, advanced from that position on the track into the stretch, came out five wide at the sixteenth pole and was under steady urging to wear down REAL LIFE in the late going. REAL LIFE, close up early while three or four wide, took over just after going six furlongs, opened a clear lead, then couldn't handle the winner's surge. ROCKING TRICK (ARG) moved to the fore inside early, made the pace for six furlongs and weakened gradually. TUBROK, bumped soundly at the start and forced in by WAVE, moved near the inside, was a bit rank, was steadied behind rivals on the first turn, edged up four or five wide on the far turn but weakened upon going six furlongs. WAVE drifted in at the start and soundly bumped with TUBROK, was angled near the inside, was rank for a half and weakened midway on the far turn. LITTLE VELVET, rank along the inside from the outset, settled finally after going a half, was finished after six furlongs and faded in the drive.
