SCREENPLAY stalked the pace in hand off of the inside, pulled to the fore midway through the second turn, shook clear entering the stretch and held safely through the drive. MONTE attended the pace along the inside, angled out to launch his bid, came three wide and finished well but was unable to reach the winner. GUNMAN was unhurried into stride along the inside, closed the gap through the second turn, shifted to the outside of OUT ON THE STREET for the final furlong and was just up to earn the show. BIG TALL PAUL settled near the tail of the field under a hard hold, angled out five wide to make a late rally but failed to seriously threaten. OUT ON THE STREET lost his footing at the start and was off slow, rushed to the lead four wide, was collared on the second turn and gave way once headed. ROSSCAT settled in the second flight, came four wide to make a belated gain but failed to threaten. MO'MILLIONS was forwardly placed three wide to the second turn and faltered. SPEEDY MON broke slowly and was never a factor.
