Footnotes

GENTLE TAP was placed towards the rear shortly after the start, raced near the inside to the final turn, moved outside to progress to the stretch then finished strong in the final sixteenth. SHRILL raced in good position along the inside for most way, offered a good run in the late going to gain place. SCUFF was allowed to settle after taking a slight lead to the first turn, pressed the pacesetter SHOTGUN SHINE from just outside that one to the lane then faded in the final going. BONAROO raced close up in the early stages, moved up to stalk the pace from the four path along the backstretch, was in striking position nearing the lane but was empty for the drive. MAPLE LEAF KITTEN was outrun shortly after the start, then improved position with a mild run late. SHOTGUN SHINE set the pace from just off the rail, briefly surrendered the advantage at the five-sixteenths pole and responded well, regained the lead to hold sway to the eighth pole, then tired in the final sixteenth. BROCK was rated on the outside, sat in good position to the final turn then lacked a response. G. W.'S D'ORO raced well off the pace while four or five wide and was not a threat. TOTEMTALE was in a good rating position near mid pack, gave ground along the final turn then fanned seven wide to the lane and stopped.
