STAKES Twin Spires Turf Sprint S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$5,000 at time of entry. \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three year olds 118 lbs.; Older 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I or II stakes on the turf since November 5, allowed 3 lbs.; \$45,000 on the turf in 2011, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. Trophy to winning owner. (If this race is taken off of the turf it will be downgraded one grade level for this running only in accordance with American Graded Stakes Committee policy). Closed Wednesday, April 13, 2011 with 27 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at Five Furlongs.)

Footnotes

REGALLY READY behind the leaders off the inside, angled out a bit for the drive and edged clear late. BRIDGETOWN closest to the pace three wide while reserved, challenged on the turn, drew clear in midstretch, could not hold the winner safe late but was clearly second best. CHAMBERLAIN BRIDGE lost his footing a bit at the start, was outrun early, commenced his rally three wide on the turn but lodged only a mild late bid. SOUTHERN REGION set the pace off the inside, held on well to midstretch and weakened. CUSTOM FOR CARLOS within striking distance three wide, maintained good position to the final furlong and tired. SPECTACULAR KID within reach early, raced in the four path on the turn and made a late gain. EARLY RETURN outrun early three wide, angled out in upper stretch but could not threaten. HENRY'S TIME trailed.
