Footnotes

LAKE HAMILTON went up early to press front-running SILVER ON SILVER from the outside, took over from that one leaving the furlong grounds and drove clear. SILVER ON SILVER drifted in on T. G. AND JAKE soon after the start, recovered to gain the lead, made the pace until the final furlong and wasn't a match for the winner late. CHIEF RED SKY, never far back, moved inside, saved ground into the final sixteenth, angled outside the top two and finished willingly. FLOAT TRIP, also within easy striking distance, moved five wide into the stretch and lacked a final response. WILSON RIDGE, well placed, moved from between foes three wide in the upper stretch but flattened out late. WATER BURST had no rally. T. G. AND JAKE, forced in at the start, was outrun to the stretch, circled foes seven wide but failed to respond. TRIPLE PLATINUM. SHINING SEA was used up forcing the pace the opening half.
