Footnotes

SMART TIMING settled early near the inside between foes, was patiently handled until the stretch, came out and split foes three wide into the final furlong, then was hard ridden to prevail. BROWN EYED LASS, unhurried early, saved ground until the upper stretch, angled five wide into the final furlong and finished willingly as second best. FOUR PLUS FOUR, forwardly placed inside from early on, appeared to shy from an object and hopped about the seven-sixteenths pole, quickly recovered, angled four wide to make a bold run into the stretch, took over but couldn't last. LAPUMA, outrun for six furlongs and racing four wide on both turns, swung out six abreast for the drive and offered a mild gain. D GERRY RAY, under light rating early while tracking the leaders four or five wide, was empty then the test came. PERSIAN SILVER rushed to the front soon after the start, maneuvered inside, made the pace until the stretch and tired in the drive. COMING OUT, six wide much of the way, flattened out in the drive. CONTESSA HALO stalked the pace for a half while four or five wide and faded. KERNITRE (GB) eased off the inside early to press front-running PERSIAN SILVER, held on well until nearing the stretch and faded. HEAVENS ABOVE was outrun.
