Footnotes

DERBY GRAY settled near the inside early, raced three wide to the far turn, came out soon after to make a sweeping run six wide approaching the stretch, reached the front approaching the final furlong and was hard ridden the remainder to hold UNION MILLS safe. The latter worked his way in nearing the first turn, tracked front-running CARSON CITY KID four or five wide, took over upon going six furlongs, lost the advantage to the winner at the furlong grounds and held on stubbornly the remainder. STORM MIST, near the inside most of the way, came out to make his run five wide leaving the eighth pole from between foes and lacked a serious late bid. NATIVE PRAIRIE, rated near the inside early, was well placed into the stretch, eased out three or four wide for the drive but came up empty. ROCK ME AMADEUS, outrun early and five wide for six furlongs, came out eight or nine wide for the stretch run, reached contention a furlong out but failed to offer a further account. CARSON CITY KID gained the lead early, maneuvered near the inside, made the pace for almost six furlongs and tired. ENGLISH, well placed from early on while tracking the leaders three or four wide, flattened out in the drive. SUMMERTIME FUJI was outrun.
