FAST COOKIE settled thee wide, edged closer on the far turn, came a bit wider to make a sweeping run approaching the stretch, wrested command when straightened for the drive and drew off under strong handling. SARATOGA CAT, unhurried early, raced three or four wide, angled six or seven wide when straightened for the drive and was all out to earn second position. PAMPERED, reserved early and three wide, came out five or six wide for the drive, improved position but wasn't a threat to FAST COOKIE. THERE RUNS HATTIE, close up between foes early, eased back inside, continued in a striking position into the lane but came up empty. MAY GATOR went up early to force the pace three abreast, raced under light rating, moved to the fore just before going six furlongs, briefly was clear, then offered no resistance when challenged. CAHILL HOLLY gained the lead near the inside early, showed the way for nearly six furlongs and gave way.
