COLIZEO angled in and set the pace along the inside, repelled the bid of RICKY TICK leaving the second turn, kicked clear and held safely through the drive. PRINCE WILL I AM was allowed to settle, responded when roused with three furlongs to run, came four wide but was unable to reach the winner. DOWN WITH DIXIE attended the pace along the inside, angled to make his bid three wide, but lacked the needed late response. RICKY TICK chased the pace two wide, drew even with five-sixteenths to run but faltered entering the stretch and gave way. ELKHORN CREEK settled in hand, ranged up three wide to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. SLAMMY BOY was allowed to settle, came five wide but lacked a response when called upon. BRAVE PROSPECT showed little. BERBERIS was shuffled back entering the first turn, settled saving ground, but came up empty on the second turn and dropped out.
