Footnotes

KING OF SPEED, reserved inside early, was checked when waiting for room at the quarter-mile ground, got through inside, continued from the rail, then wore down CATNIRO under brisk urging. CATNIRO gained the lead early, edged near the inside, raced three wide while drawing clear into the upper stretch, then had no mishap while unable to last. TARGET WEST, sluggish to begin and three or four wide throughout, improved position but couldn't threaten. VALIANT STYLE, a bit awkward at the start, went up to force the pace between foes three or four wide, came out for a stride at the three-sixteenths pole bumping SAINTS CUP, then flattened out. ANDELEGEND, never far back while following the leaders four or five wide, was empty the last eighth. SAINTS CUP chased front-running CATNIRO four wide from early on, raced in closest attendance to that one into the upper stretch, was bumped for a stride by VALIANT STYLE when that one came out, then faltered. HOLY GEM, in contention for a half while four or five wide, tired in the drive.
