Footnotes

POSSE settled three wide early, was unhurried for a half, angled out five wide for the drive and closed determinedly under strong handling to prevail. BOSSANOVA, hustled to a narrow lead early, raced three wide, made the pace into the stretch while dueling with CAT GENIUS, shook off that one, opened a clear advantage, then couldn't contain the winner's surge. COACH JIMI LEE, well placed four wide from early on, angled to the rail about the sixteenth pole but couldn't produce the needed response. CAT GENIUS went up early four or five wide to press BOSSANOVA, was rank for the opening quarter despite snug restraint, continued close up into the final furlong and faltered. CAPTAIN AMOUR, outrun early, moved inside on the turn, came out six wide for the stretch run and lacked a rally. RISKY CAT, outrun from the start and five or six wide on the backstretch, angled near the rail on the turn, continued inside the remainder and improved position while unable to menace. ELUSIVE HOUR wasn't a factor. UNBRIDLED AMERICA, seven or eight wide early while within striking distance, moved in five wide on the turn, came wider into the stretch and was finished. CAJUN BEAT, near the inside in contention for a half, weakened thereafter.
