Footnotes

KIN TO THE WIND, sluggish to start, settled near the inside, edged up between rivals on the far turn, briefly awaited room a quarter-mile out, angled five wide and drove clear late. PRECIOUS KITTEN gained a forward position early, was rated along in behind front-running VOTE EARLY, split foes when rallying entering the stretch, reached the front soon after, but wasn't a match for the winner late. MARY CAT, never far back and two or three wide, was asked for more nearing the final quarter, came out five wide in the late going and finished willingly. VOTE EARLY, bumped at the start by WHAT WILL BE and forced out on PAPPY'S GIRL, was straightened soon after and sent to the front near the inside, made the pace into the upper stretch, held on well into the lane and weakened. WHAT WILL BE bore out at the start bumping VOTE EARLY, raced four wide, continued four or five wide between foes entering the stretch and improved position while not a serious threat. PAPPY'S GIRL, bumped at the start and forced out by VOTE EARLY when that one was forced out by WHAT WILL BE, angled in soon after to press the pace, continued prominently into the stretch and weakened. UPSCALE broke slowly, was taken in hand, raced in behind rivals to the stretch, swung out eight wide entering the lane but failed to offer a late response. EGYPT bobbed at the start, settled inside, swung out three wide into the lane but failed to rally. FRENCH FERN (IRE), in contention from the outset and five wide, raced forwardly until nearing the final quarter and weakened thereafter. THUNDER BAYOU tracked the pace four or five wide for six furlongs and tired in the drive.
