GUAM TYPHOON was allowed to settle, came five wide to make his bid, reeled in HERE COMES BEN and edged clear late. HERE COMES BEN stalked the pace four wide, ranged up to engage the leaders entering the stretch, lugged in bumping FLAME JEWEL nearing the furlong marker, was straightened away and opened clear, kept on well but was unable to resist the winner. FLAME JEWEL stalked the pace three deep, drew even leaving the turn, was bumped and struck by the whip of HERE COMES BEN with a furlong to run and weakened during the drive. MR. INFLUENTIAL contended from between horses, came four wide but lacked a response when called upon. PRINCE TETON was allowed to settle, came five wide to make a mild rally but failed to seriously threaten. SOMETHING GOLD was away alertly to set the pressured pace, but weakened during the drive and gave way. RAMBLIN BOY broke awkwardly, was rank to place along the inside and was never a factor. GOOD MON showed little. WIND ANGEL was outrun. SPUNK was forwardly placed along the inside to the stretch and dropped out. The jockey of FLAME JEWEL lodged an objection against HERE COMES BEN for alleged interference in the drive, but following the Stewards review there was no change to the order of finish.
