SQUANDER was allowed to settle, ranged into striking distance four wide through the turn, kept on well and wore down the leader in the final strides. T. C. CHAMP stalked the pace two wide, forged command entering the stretch, continued on willingly but was unable to resist the winner. BEST BUDDY rushed to the lead along the inside to set the pace, was collared leaving the turn, weakened during the drive but had enough left to hold the show. ALMIGHTY SILVER was hustled along in mid pack, angled out entering the stretch, made a mild gain from between horses and improved his position. M B SEA was unhurried into stride, made a belated gain four wide but failed to threaten. GOLD BELLS SPIN was forwardly placed along the inside to the stretch and dropped out. COPY MY NOTES steadied early dropping back to last and showed little thereafter.
