CAPTAIN CRYPTO was allowed to settle, moved up swiftly through the turn, came five wide to continue the drive, caught the leaders with a sixteenth to run and kicked clear late. IT'S GOTTA BE US was bumped and carried out at the start, recovered quickly and ranged up four wide before going a half, took over entering the stretch, kept on fairly well but was unable to hold CAPTAIN CRYPTO at bay in the final yards. WON HAPPY BACHELOR was bumped at the start and unhurried into stride, made a late rally circling five wide and finished with a rush. FOOLISH PROMISE attended the pace between horses, got through entering the stretch and improved his position. WILD SUNDAY (GB) was hustled along between horses for a contending position, came four wide but went evenly through the drive. I KNOW IT'S TRUE veered out at the start, rushed up from between horses to vie for the lead, but faltered during the drive and gave way. ARCHIE TRUCKER was away alertly to set the pressured pace, disputed the issue to the final furlong and faded. LUCKY JAZZ pressed the pace along the inside, stopped before going a half and was distanced through the stretch.
