Footnotes

NECK 'N NECK tracked three wide, drew even with five-sixteenths to run, shook clear entering the stretch and widened. BIG TOWN opened clear to set the pace, was collared mid way through the second turn, proved no match for the winner but dug in gamely to preserve the place. QUIET MAN was allowed to settle, came three wide, got through between horses and was along for the show. HE'S SO PROUD stalked the pace three wide, offered his bid three wide, but weakened between horses and faded. SON OF A GENERAL was hustled along four wide, offered a mild bid on the second turn but failed to sustain the drive. BLUEGRASS JAM was forwardly placed off of the inside for six furlongs and tired. R J'S AFLEET broke a step slow, was in tight early, settled at the tail of the field, showed little thereafter, was unsaddled near the seven-eighths pole following the race and was vanned off.
