Footnotes

TURN AND RUN vied between horses, drew even four wide before going a half, battled heads apart with SONG AHEAD through a prolonged drive and narrowly prevailed. SONG AHEAD set the pressured pace three wide, was headed with a furlong to run, fought on gamely but grudgingly gave in. CRUISE DIRECTOR contended three wide, tipped out further entering the stretch, kicked on well and was getting to the leaders with every stride. BO'S SHEPARD settled saving ground, shifted out entering the stretch and improved position between rivals. FLEET DECISION was close up five wide, weakened during the drive and finished evenly. CLOBBER was forwardly placed between horses, but faltered in the final furlong and faded. LUCKY PURSUIT broke slow, was unhurried into stride and failed to make headway. NOONTIME GAMBLER prompted the pace toward the inside, but came up empty leaving the turn and retreated. CORI showed little. TUFFER was outrun.
