Footnotes

CLOAKOF VAGUENESS, lightly rated from early on while five wide, commenced a steady rally five wide nearing the final quarter, took over when straightened for the drive, then increased her advantage under steady right-handed urging. KENTUCKY WOMAN, well placed near the inside from early on, continued near the rail into the stretch, wasn't a threat to the winner but gamely earned second. RED ZINGER, reserved early, moved to the rail, lacked room from the five-sixteenths pole into the stretch, worked her way out five wide leaving the eighth pole and improved position while unable to menace seriously. NEVADA MISS, three wide between foes on the backstretch, continued behind rivals to the stretch, came out five or six wide but couldn't threaten while improving position. HARLAN CAT, outrun near the inside for five furlongs, moved with the winner while outside that one six or seven wide into the stretch, loomed prominently for the last eighth and flattened out. SILENT ALARM gained the lead early, moved near the inside, was clear leaving the backstretch, made the pace into the stretch and faltered. Y COUNTRY, nicely placed between rivals until approaching the stretch, weakened thereafter. MOODY KLAIR went up early to press front-running SILENT ALARM four wide, continued forwardly to the stretch and tired.
