TULLY'S DREAMER sent clear to dictate terms, widened leaving the turn and further into the stretch, was kept to task and held safely. SIGNING OFF attended the pace off of the inside, came three wide, shifted out further for the final furlong, continued on well but was unable to reach the winner. AIDEN'S INDY chased three wide to the final furlong, weakened but had enough left to hold the show. TOUGH NUGGIES was allowed to settle, came five wide but lacked the needed late response. CALL TO TAPS was pinched back at the start, angled to be clear, circled seven wide and finished with a mild gain. TWENTYONEANDCHANGE was allowed to settle between horses and failed to respond. DEVIL'S CHANCE bumped at the start, settled between horses and was never a factor. CARNELIAN passed only the tiring ones. SADDLE IRENA was forwardly placed four wide for a half and dropped out. THEATRE OF DREAMS bumped at the start, settled saving ground and showed little. PRECIOUS ALEENA was fractious in the gate and was always outrun.
