MALTESE SUPERB gained the lead at the start, controlled the pace under careful handling, settled into the upper stretch with a clear advantage and increased her margin under energetic hand urging. CHEER FOR SLEW, well placed inside from early on, saved ground until the stretch, came out three or four wide for the drive but couldn't menace. SPANISH GUITAR, steadied when in tight along the inside approaching the first turn, continued inside the remainder but failed to rally. DIXIE DAZZLE followed the leaders in a striking position four or five wide most of the way and was empty in the drive. GREENAPPLELEGAL eased out a bit to track the winner three or four wide, continued prominently until the stretch and weakened. MY TURN KISSIN, angled inside soon after the start, saved ground to the far turn, came out five wide but failed to rally. MILLION QUESTIONS saved ground but faded on the far turn.
