**Footnotes**

SWEETMILK CREEK, in hand early, worked her way to the inside on the backstretch, angled out four or five wide approaching the stretch, took over when straightened for the drive and widened under strong handling. RUTLEDGE DANCER, unhurried early, raced in behind horses for nearly six furlongs, came out six wide when rallying into the stretch and was up for second. LADY FROM SHANGHAI gained the advantage nearing the first turn, made the pace two or three wide until the stretch and weakened. HIGHER CIRCLE, well placed near the inside from the beginning, saved ground until approaching the final quarter, came out four wide to loomed from between foes but lacked a late response. JENNY LEE, a forward factor three or four wide from early on, moved to challenge entering the stretch, gained even terms for the lead, then flattened out the last eighth. MUSIC MUSE ducked out at the start, hit the side of the gate, moved in behind horses and failed to rally. GENTEEL, reserved early and angled inside, was outrun into the stretch, came out a bit for the drive but failed to menace. UNORTHODOX, six or seven wide most of the way, never reached contention. EL NORA, briefly in front after the start, surrendered the edge to LADY FROM SHANGHAI, continued close up outside that one for five furlongs and weakened thereafter. SADDLE UP JANET K, in contention to the far turn while following the leaders four or five wide, faded nearing the stretch.
