SCRIMSHAW settled inside, swung out deftly to be six wide concluding the turn, then was hard ridden to be along in time. ELITE MERCEDES drifted in after the start bumping DAVIDS EXPECTATION, eased out to track the pace four or five wide, made a bold bid to reach the front at the furlong grounds but couldn't handle SCRIMSHAW in the late going. COJET gained the lead early, edged in two wide, made the pace into the stretch and grudgingly weakened. STORM COMMANDER followed the leaders four wide early, moved out six or seven wide for the drive but lacked a late response. DAVIDS EXPECTATION, bumped at the start and forced in, raced inside and was empty in the stretch run. BAILEYS EDGE, forwardly placed between foes three or four wide until the stretch, faded in the drive.
