Footnotes

CAT QUATORZE gained the lead early, raced three wide under careful handling, expanded her advantage in the upper stretch and maintained it under strong hand encouragement. MORGAN'S MAMBO (GB), unhurried early, was put to a drive four wide about the five-sixteenths pole, moved a bit wider for the drive, was just off the winner for the final furlong but couldn't muster the needed response. DON'TCUSSTHEFIDDLE, steadied near the inside approaching the first turn, was never far back, eased out between horses three wide for the drive and offered a slight gain while unable to menace. S S WINNIFRED, well placed inside from the start, remained a threat into the final furlong while inside the winner but was empty. GOLDEN LEAF tracked the pace five wide to the stretch and flattened out. JUSTAKISS edged in early to press the winner four wide, held on well until approaching the stretch and weakened. RIGHT HERE, unhurried early, maneuvered to the inside, remained inside for the drive and never fired. GALVESTON GIRL wasn't a factor.
