LADY HADDASSAH was unhurried into stride off of the inside, advanced between horses through the second turn, swung six wide entering the stretch, forged command with a furlong to run and drew clear. ISLAND PRAYER was unhurried early, angled out seven wide to make a late rally and finished well to

earn the place. MADE UP settled saving ground, got through entering the stretch and was along in time to earn the show. ATSHERRYBAR settled in hand, lacked room between horses near the half mile marker, lost position, swung to the outside on the second turn, loomed a danger but faltered in the final furlong. AUDINGTON attended the pace toward the hedge, made her bid between horses but lacked the needed late kick. B. A.'S MANCINI was allowed to settle, tucked in to save ground, waited in traffic leaving the second turn and went evenly through the drive. PAOLI contested the pace three wide, opened clear on the second turn, but came up empty entering the lane and faded. COURTLY FLYER was close up four wide to the second turn and came up empty between horses. VERY SPECIAL LADY contended between horses for six furlongs and retreated. MAKENZIE'S MAGIC was bumped at the start and never a factor. CHAMAKCHALLO broke in bumping MAKENZIE'S MAGIC, was straightened away and set the pressured pace along the inside to the second turn and stopped. QUEEN ANNA was hung wide and through after a half.
