Footnotes

ELAINE'S BOOBOO, unhurried early while saving ground, made an inside move after six furlongs, was bumped by CAHILL CONNECTION with a furlong to go then finished well to be up in time. BANNER MOMENT set the pace along the inside and held on gamely in the drive but was outfinished. CAHILL CONNECTION, within striking distance off the inside, bumped the winner in midstretch then rallied well late. PRADO'S PRIDE, closest to the pace off the inside, lacked the needed late bid. CAHILL KATE, forwardly placed inside, had little left in the drive. LAST BOAT EAST, unhurried early inside, was angled out after five furlongs, came five wide into the stretch but was no threat. LACE EMBRACE, unhurried early three wide, made a four wide run on the second turn but had no late bid. COME ON LOUISE, forwardly placed three wide, raced three wide on the second turn and tired. FIREY COMET broke slow, was outrun early and was no threat. REAL CRAFTY BELLE, forwardly placed three wide, was through after six furlongs.
