Footnotes

DESIGNER PHONE moved up early to force the pace three abreast, continued in that manner into the stretch and wore down FOREST SECRETS in the final yards. FOREST SECRETS, close up inside from the outset, gained a slim lead just before going a half, made the balance of the pace while dueling and could not last while drifting out in the final sixteenth. SEVEN FOUR SEVEN gained a slim lead early while dueling between foes, lost the edge to FOREST SECRETS, continued close up until the stretch and weakened. AFTERNOON TRICK, well placed three or four wide early, came out seven wide for the drive and flattened out. BALLADO'S BABY saved ground but tired. AVALON BAY, steadied in behind rivals at the eleven-sixteenths pole, moved five wide on the turn, offered a mild bid approaching the stretch but was empty when straightened for the drive.
