Footnotes

HAIL HILLARY, nicely placed along the inside early while in hand, eased out four wide approaching the final quarter, took over in the upper stretch and increased her advantage late under strong handling. PRICE OF PASSION, never far back and five wide early, edged in a bit on the backstretch, inched to challenge SWEET BABY JANE for the lead approaching the stretch, gained almost even terms but couldn't handle HAIL HILLARY thereafter. CONSTANCY, unhurried along the inside, worked her way out five wide for the stretch run but failed to gain in the final furlong. SWEET BABY JANE gained the lead early, worked her way inside by the first turn to show the way two or three wide, made the pace to the stretch and weakened. RED BRICK AVENUE, in contention early while four wide, fell back last leaving the backstretch, swung out seven or eight wide for the drive and improved position with a mild gain. STILL AS SWEET (IRE), sluggish to start, settled behind rivals, moved out five wide on the backstretch, raced within easy striking distance to the stretch but flattened out in the drive. KISSALYSSA, forwardly place from the start, tracked front-running SWEET BABY JANE three or four wide to the far turn and gradually fell back soon after. SERVING MA MAN, lightly rated early while following the leaders four wide, weakened when called upon approaching the stretch.
