OFF DUTY settled two wide, was never far back, swung out four wide for the drive and was ridden hard to prevail. BRILLIANT SON went up between foes to gain a slim lead early, battled on even terms for a half, edged away in the upper stretch, then couldn't last while drifting in a bit at the end under right-handed urging. DJEMBE contested the pace inside of front-running BRILLIANT SON from the beginning, battled forwardly into the stretch and weakened. STUDENT COUNCIL, five wide, could gain only slightly in the late going. STAN THE MAN stumbled at the start, went up at once to force the pace three abreast, held on well for a half and gradually weakened. HELMSTAR drifted in at the start, was steadied, raced four wide in contention to the stretch and tired. MUNITION was outrun.
