**Footnotes**

BIG LORD NELSON gained the lead early, went along under careful handling near the inside, managed a clear advantage into the final furlong, then held sway under steady encouragement. SKIPEROO, nicely placed from early on along the inside, eased outside the winner three or four wide for the drive, then was slowly gaining at the end as second best. STEADY STREAK settled along the inside early, exchanged bumps with DUFFY when that one leaned in at the half-mile ground, moved between rivals on the far turn, then offered a mild late gain while three or four wide. PERMISO, reserved early three wide, angled seven wide approaching the stretch to secure racing room, leaned in and bumped twice with ARCOLA LANE at the three-sixteenths pole, forced that one in on HOVER for a stride, then lacked a final response. DUFFY, unhurried early, moved up between foes nearing the end of the backstretch, leaned in exchanging bumps with STEADY STREAK at the half-mile ground, lacked room briefly behind a wall of horses at the quarter-mile ground, angled to the rail but flattened out late. ADREAMISBORN, unhurried early, raced five wide, came out 10 wide for the stretch run and improved position while not a serious threat. RUTLEDGE MAN tracked front-running BIG LORD NELSON for six furlongs and weakened gradually. ARCOLA LANE, within striking distance while following the leaders five wide, was bumped in the upper stretch by PERMISO and forced in on HOVER, then was finished thereafter. HOVER, close up four wide to the stretch, was bumped by ARCOLA LANE when that one was forced in at the three-sixteenths and weakened thereafter. NEW SPIRITS, six wide to the stretch, came out 10 wide for the drive and was empty. After in being pulled up on the backstretch, NEW SPIRITS was vanned off.
