Footnotes

DARBOY outrun early, advanced near the rail on the turn, angled out late and was up in time. EXCITABLE BOY set the pace off the inside, drew clear on the turn, led the field into deep stretch but was outfinished. DIAMOND LAD within striking distance along the inside, angled out for the drive but lacked a late bid. SKILLS COACH reserved off the inside, lodged a mild late bid. GANDOLPH FINCH forced the pace off the inside, held on well to the final furlong and tired. GRUENEWALD within striking distance three wide, faded. MAJOR ADVANTAGE could not menace while four wide. STARBANK was outrun. GRANDDAMSLAM was through early.
