Footnotes

AUTEUR dueled for the lead along the inside, bumped repeatedly with WHIRLING THUNDER entering the stretch, kept on well and gamely edged clear. WHIRLING THUNDER dueled for the lead to the outside of AUTEUR, bumped with that one near the three-sixteenths pole and was unable to match strides through the drive. DAHLGONIT attended the pace toward the inside, got through entering the stretch and was making up ground late. LAMM settled along the inside under a hard hold, was hemmed in through the second turn, angled out to find room and finished well once clear. AYE AYE SKIPPY was forwardly placed four wide to the stretch and faded. ATOMIC FORCE chased the pace three wide, but weakened from between horses in the drive and gave way. VICTORY NOTION passed only his tiring rivals. SEA ADMIRAL saved ground to little avail. ETHICS REFORM was hustled along three wide in mid pack for six furlongs and dropped out. CAPE DOCTOR showed little.
