Footnotes

TWICE THE LADY was unhurried into stride at the tail of the field, responded when put to pressure with three furlongs to run, ranged up readily through the second turn, split horses inside the three-sixteenths pole, quickened in the final furlong and quickly drew clear. KAZ U CAN bumped with ROYAL ORDER at the start, opened clear and angled in to set the pace, controlled the tempo to inside the furlong marker but was unable to match strides with the winner. ROYAL ORDER broke a step slow and was bumped at the start, commenced a long drive along the inside, worked her way into contention entering the second turn, but weakened entering the stretch and settled for a minor award. PURE MARY was hustled along three wide, moved up to make a mild bid with a quarter mile to run but failed to sustain the drive. CLAP HANDS prompted the early pace along the inside, was nearest to the leader for five furlongs and dropped out.
