**Footnotes**

WILBURN closest to the pace off the inside, challenged after six furlongs, drew clear then lasted late. INFRATTINI outrun early, made a good middle move along the inside, was in tight attempting to split rivals in upper stretch, angled outside the winner and closed well late. SCOTUS within striking distance three wide, made a solid four wide middle move but could not sustain the bid. JEANBAPTISTE COROT drifted out at the start bothering outer rival, was reserved four wide and lacked a rally. ALSTOM unhurried near the rail, moved out to be three wide on the second turn, angled out for the drive but could not threaten. HURRICANE LAKE outrun early, made a good inside middle move but could not sustain the bid. HIDDEN PUNCH set the pace near the rail, held on well to the stretch and tired. PRAETEREO outrun early, raced five wide on the second turn and could not menace. RED ACE close up while in hand, was in tight in upper stretch and faded. FREDRIK THE GREAT bothered at the start, raced five wide on the first turn and never menaced. SHADOW WARRIOR stumbled at the start, recovered to be prominent early five wide but stopped. ELUSIVE ACTION in tight four wide entering the first turn, was through early.
