RUBYANA settled three wide early, went along in hand, rallied from the rail to take over in the upper stretch and won going away under mild urging. CHIRIMOYA, maneuvered in behind foes early, raced three wide, was never far back, came out five wide leaving the turn, was just off the winner for the last eighth but couldn't menace late. WOOF went to her knees at the start, was outrun for a half while in behind rivals, moved between horses three wide into the stretch, angled six abreast soon after and offered a minor gain. YUKI NO PRINCESS went up soon after the start to press front-running ALL OF ME from between rivals, gained a narrow lead just before going a half, held on well into the upper stretch and weakened. SERMON settled inside early, was outrun to the stretch, continued near the inside and improved position while not a threat. GRAY CACHE went up early to force the pace three abreast, battled on even terms to the stretch and faltered in the drive. BABY LETS CRUISE stumbled sharply at the start, was taken in hand four wide while outrun, came out eight wide for the drive and never threatened. ALL OF ME gained the lead at the start, raced in the three path, showed the way for nearly a half and gave way readily.
