Footnotes

TROPICAL STORM broke slowly to the inside and bumped the gate, continued inside, gained a forward position along the rail, came through close quarters while advancing at the furlong grounds, brushed with SMOKEN SMOKE, then drove clear. TUSIN TAK, well placed near the inside early, eased out three or four wide while advancing into the stretch, loomed outside the winner late but was second best. SMOKEN SMOKE gained the advantage early, edged inward, raced two or three wide, leaned in at the furlong grounds and brushed with the winner and weakened thereafter. STARS ABOVE, outsprinted four wide early, came out six wide for the drive and offered a mild gain. ARTEMUS PAPERBOY, forced out at the start, was outrun to the stretch, swung out five wide for the drive and offered a minor gain. DANCING BABA ducked out at the start, forced EAST WING out, raced in contention five or six wide to the stretch and was empty in the drive. OCOTILLO stalked the pace four or five wide into the final furlong and flattened out. EXPEDIENT tired on the turn. EAST WING, bumped at the tart by DANCING BABA and forced out, never was prominent. ISHI NARU was outrun.
