Footnotes

CAROLINA ROSE tracked the dueling leaders in hand from early on while four wide, inched to challenge leaving the eighth pole, gained a slight edge and was kept to her task. TWO MILE HILL gained as slim lead inside early, raced under rating while dueling with SHORWALK DRIVE, was displaced briefly by that one on the backstretch, regained the edge, lost it again to the winner leaving the furlong grounds and held on stubbornly the remainder. PLAID broke in the air, bobbed when landing awkwardly, was unhurried, advanced four wide on the far turn, angled six wide into the stretch, loomed a threat for the last eighth but couldn't offer the needed response. FARHANA, never far back and three wide to the end of the backstretch, edged closer to the inside on the far turn, remained inside for the drive and lacked a closing kick. MAID OF HONOR settled inside, raced in contention for seven furlongs and tired. SHOREWALK DRIVE moved up soon after the break to vie for the lead outside of TWO MILE HILL, headed that one briefly on the backstretch, lost the advantage back to TWO MILE HILL, continued forwardly to the lane and faltered.
