Footnotes

AHURIRI HIKAWAI (NZ) settled four wide early, came out six wide when straightened for the drive to advance between rivals and was hard ridden to be along in time. NICOLE'S DREAM gained the lead near the inside early, edged clear in the upper stretch, then had no mishap while unable to last. BIG SCORE, nicely placed inside into the stretch, eased outside of front-running NICOLE'S DREAM three of four wide but couldn't produce a final response. SET TO SPARKLE tracked the pace four or five wide into the final furlong and came up empty. MISS PENNY FORTUNE, within easy striking distance four or five wide throughout, flattened out when the test came. DRIPPINGINDIAMONDS, sluggish to begin, raced four wide early, maneuvered six wide while edging closer on the turn, came out a bit wider on the course for the drive but was empty late. JENNY'S PROSPECTOR raced prominently between foes to the stretch and tired.
