CAPT. CANDYMAN CAN settled behind rivals under a snug hold, worked his way forward off of the inside while in hand, shifted out to launch his bid leaving the turn, joined the vanguard from between horses in the upper stretch and inched away through the drive. CASH REFUND dueled for the lead two wide, dug in gamely to meet the bid of CAPT. CANDYMAN CAN, battled with that one through a prolonged drive but was turned away late. CONCHACER chased the dueling leaders three deep, came four wide to make his bid, weakened during the drive but kept on fairly well to hold the show. ZIGAREE dropped well back, made a belated gain along the inside but was never a factor. DANCE CALLER dueled for the lead along the inside, was headed entering the stretch and gave way readily thereafter.
