OAK BAR stalked the pace three deep, launched his bid leaving the turn, forged command and steadily drew clear. MR. REALISTIC attended the pace along the inside, split horses to make his move leaving the turn, dropped back to the rail entering the stretch, slipped through to the inside of SGT. EMBLETON and finished willingly for the place. SGT. EMBLETON vied for the lead between horses, was unable to match strides with OAK BAR after six furlongs, weakened further in the drive and was all out to hold the show. BROTHER STUART broke slowly, was hustled along to recover the lost ground three wide, offered a mild bid nearing the quarter pole but failed to sustain the drive. CAME AND GONE lagged well behind his field, finished with a belated gain but was never a factor. RIDGE CITY rushed to the lead between horses, disputed the issue to the turn and dropped out.
