SPOON RIVER LEW settled in hand toward the inside, advanced between horses through the turn, assumed command entering the stretch and quickly drew clear. W. W.'S LADY'S MAN set the pressured pace three wide, was collared entering the stretch, was unable to match strides with the winner but safely held the place. ROYAL CAPE chased the pace three wide, lacked a response when called upon and settled for a minor award. THREEFORALL pressed the pace along the inside, but came up empty on the turn and dropped out. VETERAN'S DAY was always outrun, eased to the wire but walked off.
