Footnotes

MONSIEUR CAT, unhurried early, edged inward to race four wide, advanced from that position on the course around the second turn, came out a bit farther for the stretch run and was hard ridden to wear down SALOMON SWAGGER. The latter came out soon after the start exchanging bumps with NEWTOWN JET, tracked the leaders from early on while three or four wide, moved with a rush to take over in the upper stretch, gained a clear advantage, then couldn't contain the winner in the late stages. TREMMOR, unhurried early while maneuvered near the inside, edged up three wide on the second turn, came out to make a run from between foes five wide nearing the final furlong but gained only slightly at the end. PLEASANT KING, angled inside soon after the start, followed the winner five wide on the second turn, came out eight or nine wide for the drive, loomed a solid threat for the last eighth but failed to gain. NEWTOWN JET leaned in after the start exchanging bumps with SALOMON SWAGGER, settled along the inside, lacked room at the quarter-mile ground, then, when the inside cleared, couldn't make up the difference. NEWSPEAK, in contention near the inside early, fell back approaching the stretch, angled six wide for the drive but was empty. PENINSULA gained the lead inside early, made the pace until the final quarter and tired. ARMADA, well placed inside from the outset, faded in the drive. SOMETHING PLEASANT pressed front-running PENINSULA from the start, battled on about even terms outside that one until the stretch and tired. COPPER TRICK followed the leaders in contention five or six wide for six furlongs and weakened thereafter.
