Footnotes

WICKED COOL gained the lead soon after the start, edged clear, moved inside, went along under careful rating, repelled a bid from SASSY SIX just after going six furlongs, then drew off in the final furlong under energetic encouragement. SLAUGHTER AND RUN, unhurried early, made a sweeping bid five wide approaching the stretch, was just off the winner through the drive but couldn't menace late as second best. ROAD QUEEN moved up soon after the break to track the leaders four or five wide, continued in that manner most of the way and lacked a closing account. SASSY SIX settled in behind rivals early, eased out three wide to make a serious challenge approaching the stretch but flattened out in the drive. RAISING SALEM, outrun for six furlongs while three wide, circled foes eight wide into the stretch and improved position while unable to menace. KAT CAN DANCE moved up soon after the start to chase the winner three or four wide, continued forwardly for five furlongs and tired. CERTIFIED APPROVAL broke a bit awkward and bobbed, raced six wide and wasn't a factor. CHANGE THE PLAY, well placed inside for six furlongs, weakened thereafter.
