DONOHARM moved up along the inside leaving the chute to vie for the lead, took over before a half then drew off under steady urging. SCAT CHIEF forwardly placed off the inside, lodged a mild bid for the place and was clearly second best. MANLY prompted the pace off the inside, held on well to the stretch and tired. KARMA SHIELD forwardly placed three wide, stayed on well to the stretch and gave way. CERTAIN SWAGGER within striking distance four wide, faded. PORTMAN contested the early pace outside, raced five wide midway through the turn and faded. MIDWAY IN pulled early and was no threat. BULLDOG LEGEND steadied leaving the chute when in tight then broke down near the five furlong marker.
