GENTLEMEN'S BET sped clear to set the pace, turned back the bid of HAMILTONIAN entering the stretch and quickly drew clear. GOOD MORNING DIVA was allowed to settle, circled five wide and finished willingly to earn the place. HAMILTONIAN stalked the pace, ranged up to engage the leader leaving the turn, but wilted in the drive and settled for the show. TRIUMPH AND SONG stumbled at the start, moved up three wide, came four wide to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. CANDY BITES saved ground to little avail. FLASHY DRESSER went wide and was never a factor.
