Footnotes

REPARTMENT, well placed from early on, tracked the dueling leaders four wide, advanced from that position and was hard ridden to prevail. PRIVATE GOLD leaned in at the break bumping OMINOUS, was well placed in behind rivals into the stretch, angled five wide at the furlong grounds but wasn't good enough. ILL BUY DINNER gained the lead early, dueled with BOSTON PARK into the final furlong and weakened. BOSTON PARK moved up inside to contest the pace early, battled with ILL BUY DINNER into the final furlong and weakened. RISKY CAT drifted in at the start bumping TIN EYE, raced in contention five wide to the lane, came out farther for the drive and was empty late. OMINOUS, bumped at the start by PRIVATE GOLD when that one leaned in, came out nine wide for the drive and lacked a final account. FORTY SECOND ST., six or seven wide much of the way, lacked a late response. LONE STAR DEPUTY, near the inside, weakened in the drive. GRIN AND FROWN, eight wide on the backstretch and outrun, continued well off the inside on the turn and was 10 wide in the stretch while unable to menace. KING CARSON, in behind rivals four wide much of the way, weakened in the drive. TIN EYE drifted in at the start, raced greenly while outrun and never was close. RING OF POWER, bumped at the start when RISKY CAT drifted in, never was closed and raced six wide much of the way.
