Footnotes

SOUTHERN SURPRISE gained the lead early, raced under a rating hold from the three path, settled into the final furlong with a clear lead and was kept to her task to increase the margin. LOOKN MIGHTY FINE came out at the start bumping SUDDENLY GONE, settled in hand, raced five wide from the backstretch on and was fully extended to earn second while no threat to the winner. CAUGHT IN THE RAIN moved up early to track the winner three or four wide, continued close up into the stretch and weakened. BAG OF STARS, never far back, moved up four or five wide leaving the backstretch, continue prominently into the final furlong and flattened out. SUDDENLY GONE, bumped at the start and taken in hand, moved out six wide on the backstretch, continued six wide the remainder and failed to rally. LOOKING AFAR, angled in behind the winner early, saved ground while forwardly place to the stretch, remained inside and faltered in the drive.
