Footnotes

LATTICE stalked the pace from the beginning while three or four wide, wrested command in the upper stretch, kicked clear, then was all out to last. NIAGARA CAUSEWAY followed the leaders four wide around the first turn and into the backstretch, remained off the inside, inched up nearing the lane, had clear aim through the drive and missed. THIS IS THAT settled three wide early, made a five wide run into the final furlong and failed to sustain his move while drifting out late. MALAMEEZE, bumped at the break by PROVE YOURSELF and forced out, was unhurried, raced three wide, worked his way out five wide in the drive and improved position. TOUCHDOWN PEYTON, outrun to the far turn, raced five wide into the lane and improved position. PROVE YOURSELF swerved out at the start bumping MALAMEEZEZE, raced in contention four or five wide to the stretch and was empty. LOUSHE, rank while sprinting clear inside early, made the pace for six furlongs and tired. HIGHER CAUSE chased the pace three wide, weakened and was pulled up lame at the furlong grounds. HONDO RUN was outrun and pulled up lame on the far turn. Both injured runners were vanned off. THIS RACE WAS HAND TIMES IN 1:42.91.
