Footnotes

INTERESTING gained a slim lead from the three-path early while dueling with NO LLORES CATITA (CHI), shook off that one leaving the turn, drew clear and was kept to her task. NO LLORES CATITA (CHI) contested the pace from between foes early, raced in closest attendance to the winner most of the way and was all out to save the place. LIVELY CLASSIC, within easy striking distance and racing inside to the lane, angled four or five wide and couldn't offer the needed response. MISS CONNIE SUE worked her way in behind rivals early, continued from the rail and lacked room very late. COME ON CATHY ANN, reluctant to load into the gate, broke sluggishly, was outrun to the lane and improved position while not a serious threat. PICATA, well placed four wide, flattened out in the drive. GRAN NIETA never reached prominence. PUT AWAY THE HALO, close up early, began attempting to bear out leaving the backstretch, was steadied, continued six wide and tired. ELMIRA never was factor. THIS RACE WAS HAND TIMED IN 56.87.
