Footnotes

MELLOW FELLOW sprinted clear, set the pace off the inside, responded willingly when challenged in upper stretch and proved best under pressure. Z DAGER forwardly placed off the inside, saved ground on the second turn, made a run at the winner while inside that one in midstretch but missed. FINNEGANS WAKE unhurried along the inside, angled off the rail on the second turn when slowly moving up while in traffic, moved back in a bit once in the stretch and made a late gain. AT THE PULPIT closest to the pace three wide, made a run at the winner in upper stretch but weakened late. TREND eager early when within striking distance and three wide, moved out a path on the second turn and lodged a mild late bid. LIL BIT O'FUN bobbled at the start, was outrun off the inside, moved out to be in the four path on the second turn and showed late interest. PERREGAUX within reach off the inside, lacked a late bid. STRIKE IMPACT stumbled at the start, recovered to be close up four wide, moved in a path on the second turn and lacked a late bid. SET THE SAIL

steadied approaching the first turn when in tight, was reserved for a half, made a four wide middle move but could not sustain the bid. SOUTHERN PARKWAY steadied after the start when in tight, was unhurried for a half, steadied near the three furlong marker when FINNEGANS WAKE moved off the rail then was no threat. VALEDICTION in close quarters early, recovered to be close up, saved ground on the second turn and could not menace late. SETON HALL was outrun while wide.
